



Homework Club Support Work

This course is aimed at unemployed adults with an interest in working with children. It is based on attending one day a week on Tuesdays from 9.30am to 2.30pm and volunteering twice a week after school at the community centre's homework club. A DBS check will be required.

Participants will learn how to help a child with literacy and numeracy and in particular:

- How to make learning fun for a child
- How to assess a child's progress
- How schools monitor a child's progress
- How to find free resources to help a child learn

This course will help you support your child's learning. Participants can also be referred onto more advanced courses at the Manchester College and train to work as teaching assistants in schools.
